
A look to this Month

In Reading: First graders will be working on Journeys:
A tree is a plant (Informational text) - Sequence of the story.
Grow Apples Grow! (Informational Text) - Captions
Seasons (Informational Text) - Cause and Effect.
Four Seasons for Animals (Informational Text) - Heading



For Writing: The students are beginning to work on writing informative/explanatory texts. They will continue working on using correct grammar, writing complete sentences, using punctuations, and different parts of speech in their writing.

In Mathematics: The students will find three addends using the strategies they learned in previous months, such as making a ten and adding doubles. The students will also use the making ten strategies to subtract a single-digit number from a teen number.



For Peace Education: This month, the students will learn about different strategies such as breathing in and out to relax their muscles. These strategies will help them to become better citizens.



For Social Studies: The students learned about how to read a map using the compass rose. In January, the students will continue learning about maps and will create their maps. First graders will identify different locations on the Florida map.

In Science: The students will be learning about the different patterns that happen on Earth and will be introduced to gravity law. First-grader will be working with vertebrates and invertebrate animals and the observable properties of matter.
