Our Lessons

In Reading, the 4th graders will learning how to cite text evidence and understand the concept of irony. All students are practicing their inferencing, vocabulary in context and synonyms and antonyms. The students will also be learning about analyzing sentences and finding the subject and predicate.

In Writing, the students will be learning to watch out for sentence fragments, using stronger verbs and adjectives in their writing and revising their writing by adding dialogue or sensory details. We are currently working on the 6 quality traits of writing: ideas, organization, voice, sentence fluency, strong word choice, and conventions.

In Social Studies, the students will be learning the symbols of Florida and early Florida History. We will also be celebrating Hispanic Heritage month. The students will be learning when it was created and learn about historical hispanic figures.

In Mathematics, the students will be continuing to work on word problems involving multiplication and division, multiples and factors, numbers and equations, patterns and will dive into multi-step problems. They will also continue thier geometry studies.

In Cosmic the students will be focusing on how matter and energy came together to form stars, atoms, and galaxies. We will learning about constellations, planets and continue with the Timeline of the Universe.

In Physical Science, students will be continuing to learn about types of energy with chemical changes, change in motion, vibration (sound energy) and energy in water.
