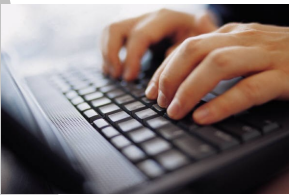

Our Lessons

- * In Reading, Students will be reading Journeys Lessons 4-Diary of a Spider-Humorous Fiction (Cause and Effect), and A swallow and a spider-Fable(Moral). They will learn about poetry and fiction: pumpkins, pumpkins and Too many Pumpkins by Linda White (Fiction). Also, they will learn about informational text: How many seeds in a Pumpkin? By Margaret McNamara.
- * In writing, The students will be working on Writing City. They will be learning how to write a Narrative story.
- * In Math, Students will be working on finding unknown numbers, solving two-step word problems and Two digit subtraction.
- * In Social studies, The students will be working on the celebrations of Spanish heritage and the daily lives of the people living in colonial America.
