#### **Our Lessons**

In **Social Studies**, the third graders will be learning about physical features and Landmarks of the United States, Canada, Mexico & the Caribbean.

In **Reading**, third graders will begin humorous fiction and informational text using Journeys. Students will focus on story structure, analyzing illustrations, and summarizing text. Third grade will also focus on fluency, phonics skills, and using context clues.

In **Writing**, third graders will be completing Unit 2 of the Writing program, Narrative Writing. Third Graders will begin Unit 3 of the Writing program,

Informative/Explanatory Writing. They will focus on parts of speech (pronouns, verbs, adjectives, and adverbs), capitalizing appropriate words in titles, and using commas.

In Mathematics, third graders will practice their fluency of multiplication facts. They will also work on understanding how multiplications and division are connected as well as start to understand patterns.

In **Biology/Science**, third graders will be observing and studying the growth of a plant through an in-class or Zoom experiment.

Our **Cosmic** curriculum (Montessori), the students will be studying stars, parts of an atom, galaxies, the solar system/planets, and the constellations.
